A couple stories of the women we help thanks to your generosity...

Margaret, and her three children (ages 4-9) made the decision to sell her car in order to rent a room to escape an abusive relationship with the children's father. She found herself pregnant again and called us saying that she was considering an abortion, telling us that she and the and the children were living together in crowded conditions in a single room in a townhouse and could barely afford the rent from her disability check. She had no job, was receiving food stamps and would need financial assistance to continue staying in the room, so we made an appointment for her to have an ultrasound and to see how we could help her.

Margaret's friends were telling her to abort because she already had three children and couldn't "afford" to have another child. But when Margaret saw her baby on ultrasound, she fell in love with her baby and chose life! She later gave birth to a little boy named Amir.

Mom and baby are doing fine and A Best Choice Mobile Ultrasound is helping her with part of the rent and utilities, and trips via Uber until she finds a job. She is hopeful that day will come soon.

Zaynes 6/15/19 **Vickey,** called us on a Saturday wanting an abortion. I told her about the 24 hour waiting period and requirement to obtain an ultrasound before getting an abortion. We found out that she had just moved from New York and was living with her sister in Petersburg, which was about two hours away from Northern Virginia. I counseled her on the phone and told her that abortion was not the right choice for her physical, spiritual and mental health and that there was help that we could offer to her. I quickly called Heartbeat International's hotline to find a pregnancy resource center close by that could offer her more counseling and a free ultrasound.

We credit Divine intervention that there was a pregnancy resource center in Richmond that could see her that day. The Director of the center said that they gave her a free ultrasound which showed that she was fifteen weeks pregnant and started to lean more towards life. It turns out that Vickey's sister, who she is living with, can't have children and offered to adopt her baby! God works in amazing ways!

ABC's mission continues even after we help a pregnant woman choose life. We offer moral support for her life-affirming decision and financial support for rent, utilities, transportation along with referrals for pre-natal care and housing.

In order to provide our services, our mission requires a steady flow of funds. And, with just a few more weeks left in this year I am writing to you today, to ask for your support with our pro-life mobile ultrasound ministry.

It is no exaggeration to say that ABC, the pro-life movement-and you, our supporters- are engaged in a great spiritual battle being waged in our nation for the lives of innocent babies and the welfare of mothers facing an unexpected pregnancy. Many feel pressured by the father of the baby, family members, and friends to have an abortion, mostly due to financial conditions.

Pressured to abort and left to fend for themselves, many of these women-often from unstable homes-feel abandoned. And they are. It is heartbreaking to see women facing an unplanned pregnancy knowing the pressure and poverty so many face.

But on their trip to the abortion clinic something happened: by the hand of God, they found us in their path and we found them a path to choose life, a blessing for them and for us.

In Defense of the Unborn

Virginia Governor Ralph Northam made the hideous statement that if a baby survives an abortion, the baby should be kept "comfortable" and a conversation would ensue between the mother and her doctor to decide if the baby should live or die. This comment sparked moral outrage across the U.S. and as a result, many states introduced Heartbeat Bills to protect unborn children once their heartbeat is detected, usually at six weeks.

Ideally, a bill for the protection of "Life at Conception" is what pro-life legislators are aiming for, but every law we can acquire to defend the lives of the unborn will work toward our fight for protecting them from conception to birth.
